The **Northville Art House** is seeking original artwork created in pastel by U.S. artists, 18 and older.

Admission and Hours: Free. Tue - Thu 10 am – 5 pm &
Fri - Sat 11 – 3 pm. Extended hours as advertised.

Reception: Saturday, April 22, 5 – 7 pm with Awards
Presentation at 6:15 PM; Free for artists and guests

Awards: \$650 in cash awards for 1st – 4th Place: \$300,
\$200, \$100, and \$50; Honorable Mention Awards.

Eligibility: U.S. Artists, 18 and over, may submit up to
3 ORIGINAL works created in at least 80% pastel –
hard, soft, dry, pencil, and/or PanPastel. All subjects
and styles eligible. Work must be created within the
last 5 years, and not previously exhibited at the
Northville Art House. Work should be framed under
glass or plexiglass. The maximum size of all artworks
including the frame is 54" in any direction.

Entry Deadline: All entries MUST be submitted at
www.northvillearthouse.org/exhibitions/opportunities/pastel

by **Sunday, February 26, 11:59 PM EST.**

Entry Procedures: Enter artist contact information
with the title, medium, size, and price for each piece.
Works are preferred to be for sale.

Entry Images: Submit jpg or jpeg digital images in less
than 4MB and labeled as **LastName-ArtworkTitle.jpg**.
Please submit quality photos as these will be used for
the jury process, promotion, and online store sales.

Entry Fee: Non-refundable fees of \$40 for **non-**
members and \$30 for **Northville Art House members**,
entitles each artist to submit up to 3 artworks.

Art Sales: A 35% commission to the Northville Art
House is accepted on all sales. Work is for sale in the
gallery, by phone, and online.

Notification of Acceptance: Artists will be notified by
email on **Monday, March 13**. An optional label will be
supplied to temporarily affix to the back of the artwork.

Presentation: Artwork must be in excellent condition,
labeled on back with name and title, and ready for
secure hanging. Works to be framed with glass or
plexiglass with hooks and a wire on back. **NO sawtooth
hangers.** Accepted works must be the same as
submitted images.

Shipping: All costs, including packing, shipping, and
liability for damage, are the artist's responsibility. A
pre-paid return label, stamps, or payment for shipped
artwork must be included as well as instructions for
special installations. Send tracking number to

Delivery: Hand-delivered artwork drop-off times are
April 2 - 3, 12 – 2 pm. Pre-paid shipped artwork must
arrive on or before **April 3**.

Art Pick-Up: All artwork must remain in the exhibition
through **May 6**. Unsold artwork may be picked-up
on **May 7 - 8, 12 – 2 PM**, and after during regular
gallery hours. Artists may call or email ahead to
authorize a representative to pick-up their work.
Shipped artwork will be packed and returned in the
same or similar material by **May 12**. Artwork not picked
up 30 days after the exhibition will be considered
abandoned and become Northville Art House property.

Terms and Conditions: Submissions to the exhibition
shall constitute an agreement to comply with the terms
and conditions set forth in the call for entries, entry
form, and in the [Art Exhibition and Sales Agreement](#).

The **Northville Art House** reserves the right to exclude
any art that doesn't meet the terms and conditions, is
deemed offensive, or violates laws of the United States.
