Supply List: Acrylic and Oil Painting Studio

Below is the list of supplies you will need for the class. You can find these items at local art supply stores such as Blick, Michaels or Hobby Lobby, and online retailers like Amazon.com or DickBlick.com. Feel free to purchase them from any store you prefer. If you have any questions about the supplies, please email us at office@northvillearthouse.org.

Please bring any art supplies you already have. If you are currently working on something, feel free to bring it along, or bring a photo or idea for a project you'd like to work on.

Canvas

Any size you are comfortable with or already own

Paint

- For Beginners: Start with a limited palette for the first class:
 - Red
 - o Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Titanium White
- Bring any other colors you may already have
- If possible, avoid basic student-grade paints as they often have less pigment, which may result in needing more paint to achieve the same effect. Artist-grade or mid-range paints offer better value in the long run. Additional colors can be discussed during the first class.

Essential Supplies

- Paper Towels
- Small Table Covering (we will provide a standing or table easel)
- Palette: a disposable palette pad, regular palette, or even paper plates for acrylics work well
- · Palette knife: optional, but helpful for mixing and applying paint. One simple knife is sufficient

Brushes

- · Acrylic Painters:
 - Use synthetic brushes
 - Suggested sizes: ¼ inch, ½ inch, and 1-inch flat brushes, plus one small round brush
 - Please bring any brushes you already have
 - We will provide water containers for acrylic painters
- · Oil Painters:
 - o Minimum of 3 brushes: one round, one flat, and one filbert
 - Inexpensive natural or synthetic brushes are fine for now. Bring any you already have
 - Odorless mineral spirits (such as Gamsol) for cleaning and thinning paint
 - Two airtight containers (e.g. jars with lids) for storing your spirits.

Rags, a water container, and an easel will be provided for you in class.
