

Supply List: Impressionistic to Abstract Oil Painting

Below is the list of supplies you will need for the class. You can find these items at local art supply stores such as Blick, Michaels or Hobby Lobby, and online retailers like Amazon.com or DickBlick.com. Paints

Recommended brands: Winsor & Newton Artist Oil Paints (not Winton water-soluble). For those who like acrylic, Rose recommends Golden Open Acrylics, which have a longer blending time. You can use any paints you have, but these are suggested.

Essential Colors:

- Titanium White, Ivory Black
- Warm Colors: Cadmium Red Light, Cadmium Lemon, Cadmium Yellow Light, Cerulean Blue, Viridian
- Cool Colors: Alizarin Crimson, Magenta, Ultramarine Blue, Winsor Green (Phthalo)
- Optional (if budget allows): Cobalt Blue, Dioxazine Purple, Cadmium Orange

Mediums

- Oil Painters: Linseed Oil & Odor Free Mineral Spirits
- Acrylic Painters: Matte Medium

Brushes

- Flats (Flat Edged) & Filberts (Rounded Edge): Sizes 2, 4, 8, 10, 12
- Oil Painters: Natural or synthetic bristles
- Acrylic Painters: Synthetic bristles
- Detail Brush: Rigger or liner brush (Cotman Watercolor Brush #4 works well for all mediums)

Canvases

- **If you're planning to work in an Impressionistic Style**
 - (1) 5" x 7" canvas board
 - (1) 8" x 10" canvas board
 - (1) 9" x 12" canvas board
 - Returning students can work on a larger scale: 11" x 14" and 16" x 20" canvas boards
 - Recommended Brand: Centurian canvas boards
- **If you're planning to work in an abstract style**
 - (2) 4" x 4 ½" canvas boards
 - (2) 6" x 6 ½" canvas boards
 - (1) 24" x 24 ½" wrapped canvas
 - Returning students can work on a larger scale: (2) 24" x 24 ½" wrapped canvases
 - Recommended Brand: Centurian canvas boards

Additional Supplies

- Palette Mixing Pad (Disposable): 16" x 20" or larger recommended
- Palette Knife: Medium size, bent with a pointed, triangular shape
- Returning abstract students can also bring texturing tools, scrapers, rubber combs, etc.
- Sketchbook, Pencil, Eraser, Ruler
- Sharpie Black Markers: Fine point & extra fine point
- Old Cotton T-Shirts (cut up) or Blue Paper Towels
- Small Container with Lid: For medium storage

Extras

- Rubber Gloves: (Available at Costco or any preferred brand)
- Apron or Old Clothes
- Clean Pizza Box: Great for transporting smaller wet paintings (ask for an extra one next time you order pizza)



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
