- 1 pad 11" x 14" (or larger) Strathmore 400 drawing paper
- 6+ HB, 2H, 4H pencils. Staedtler Lumograph brand are preferred.
- 2 pencil extenders
- 1 4-hole Art Pencil Sharpener, Sketch Sharpener, Long Lead Grinding Tool
- 18" or larger T-square
- An 18" x 24" or larger drawing board. The Helix Wooden Lightweight Drawing Board is a good option
- Artist Tape
- Kneaded rubber eraser
- Mono Zero eraser
- 1 Artist 11 inch Proportional Divider Drafting Tool
- 1 set Learning Resources Store brand of shapes. Will need to painted matte white.
- Flat white 11 inch bust of Michelangelo's David
- Cardboard box and black duct tape to make a shadow box. Can also use a pre-built shadow box.
- Light: Both of these lights look like they would work. Feel free to get the one that you like better
